**The Insolvency (Fees) Regulations, 2024**

*(Under section 260 (1) of the Insolvency Act, 2011, Act 14 of 2011)*

**IN EXERCISE** of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for justice, by section 260 of the Insolvency Act, 2011 these Regulations are made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2024.

**1. Title**

These Regulations may be cited as the Insolvency (Fees) Regulations, 2024.

**2. Fees**

The fees specified in the Schedule to these Regulations shall be paid in respect of the matters they relate to under the Insolvency Act, 2011.

**3. Revocation of S.I No. 77 of 2023**

The Insolvency (Fees) Regulations, 2023, are revoked.

20.	For filing of a return	55,000
21.	For certification of a document on the register maintained by the official receiver	35,000 for the first three copies and 10,000 for each extra copy.
22.	Filing of notice of provisional administration	35,000
23.	For any other document filed with the official receiver	35,000”
